

Student #4: CG

A friend is a good key to success,"also." When having a good friend you'll have someone to help you with the problems you may face someone down the line or just having someone you can just to with and hang-out with.

I include this example because it is so commonly seen in students' writing. The student has several ideas (starting with the first sentence), but they are jumbled together in the writer's mind as well as on paper. I use the arrows or lines to suggest a revision strategy to the CG. By forcing CG to restate each segment as a separate thought or even a list of complete sentences, I am also helping this struggling writer organize her thoughts. This would eventually become a writing lesson in which the sentence above served as rough draft. As one author said, "I don't always know what I think until I see what I say."
